Before the court are two motions for reconsideration filed by petitioner Andrew Matthew Obrecht. First, he asks this court to reconsider its March 14, 2008 order denying petitioner's request for a certificate of appealability. Second, he asks the court to reconsider its March 13, 2008 order denying petitioner's motion to construe a set of "auxiliary submissions" filed on November 29 and December 4, 2007 as a motion under Fed. R. Civ. P. 60(b)(1) for relief from the judgment.

The motions will be denied. Petitioner's challenges to the court's orders reflect little more than his own disagreement with the correctness of this court's conclusion. Petitioner can make those arguments to the court of appeals, which now has jurisdiction over his case.

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner's motions to alter or amend the judgment (dkt. #36) are DENIED.
