On March 28, 2007, this court held a telephonic pretrial motions hearing. Defendant David Escobar did not participate personally, but was represented by his attorney, Jeff W. Nichols. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Robert Anderson.

Prior to the hearing, Escobar filed no pretrial motions. Attorney Nichols stated that this was a tactical decision he made in consultation with his client after adequate review of the government's disclosures and after adequate investigation of the case. The government then provided a discovery proffer. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. Because it is unclear whether the case is going to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
