PRETRIAL MOTION  
HEARING ORDER

On July 11, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Gary Prideaux-Wentz was present with his attorney, Lawrence Bensky. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Laura Przbylinski Finn.

Prior to the hearing, I had denied Prideaux-Wentz's request for a *Franks* hearing in a separate order; all that remained at the hearing was to set a briefing schedule. Prideaux-Wentz may have until July 20, 2007 within which to file and serve his brief in support of suppression. The government may have until July 27, 2007 within which to respond; Prideaux-Wentz may have until August 1, 2007 within which to file and serve his reply. Same day service during business hours is required for all briefs. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
