PRETRIAL MOTION  
HEARING ORDER

07-CR-101-S

On August 23, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Rodney Sykes was present with his attorney, Kelly Welsh. Defendant Walter Fox was present with his attorney, William Jones. Defendant James Sanderson was present with his attorney, Brian Mullins. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Elizabeth Altman.

Prior to the hearing, defendants Sykes and Fox filed pretrial motions related to discovery. After discussing the motions with both sides, I granted those docketed as 25, 27, and 31, granted in part and denied in part 26 and 33, and denied 24, 28-30, 32, 34, and 35. Defendant Sanderson filed no pretrial motions. Attorney Mullins stated that this was a tactical decision he made in consultation with Sanderson after adequate review of the government's disclosures and after adequate independent investigation of this case. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
