Defendant Kylin Little has filed a motion pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582, seeking a reduction of the sentence entered on March 28, 2008. His term of imprisonment was 95 months, which was at about the midpoint of the sentencing guideline range of 84 to 104 months. Under the amended guidelines, defendant has an advisory guideline range of 57 to 71 months.

Defendant has asked for a sentence of 57 months, at the bottom of the amended sentencing range. The government argues for a decrease to the same approximate point within the amended range or 64 months.

I am persuaded that a sentence of 64 months is reasonable and sufficient to protect

the community, provide defendant the opportunity for substance abuse counseling and other rehabilitative programs, including vocational training, and achieve parity with the sentences of similarly situated offenders.

#### ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the judgment and commitment order entered on March 28, 2008 is AMENDED to provide that the sentence imposed on defendant Kylin Little is reduced to 64 months. In all other respects, the judgment and commitment order remains as entered on March 28, 2008.
