Defendant Calvin Watson has filed a motion under Fed. R. Crim. P. 35 for a reduction of the sentence imposed on him on April 15, 2008. Because the government has not filed any motions to reduce defendant's sentence, his request must be DENIED. A sentencing court has no independent authority to reduce a sentence once it has been imposed. The only circumstances in which the court can reduce the sentence are after a sentence has been overturned on appeal or the government has moved for a reduction under Rule 35.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Calvin Watson's request for a reduction of sentence is DENIED.
