On December 20, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing and an unscheduled *ex parte* hearing. Starting with the *ex parte* hearing, I met with defendant Telly Kingcade and Attorney David Mandell to discuss Kingcade's concerns about the direction in which his case is headed. I concluded that Attorney Mandell may remain as Kingcade's attorney. We then resumed the pretrial motion hearing, with Assistant United States Attorney John Vaudreuil joining the proceedings.

Prior to the hearing, Kingcade filed a series of discovery motions and two suppression motions. After discussing the course of discovery and the motions with both sides, I denied the motions docketed as 18, 19 and 20, and left open for briefing the motions docketed as 15-17, and 21. Kingcade's first briefs in support of his motions must be filed and served not later than January 2, 2008. The government must file its responses not later than January 9, 2008. Any reply must be filed and served by January 16, 2008. I will wait to provide draft voir dire and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadilne for the final

pretrial conference. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
