The parties have finished briefing defendants' motions for summary judgment for plaintiff's failure to exhaust his administrative remedies before filing these three cases. Now plaintiff has written a letter to the court in which he states that prison officials have just returned to him documents that show he completed the grievance process for some of the claims at issue. Inexplicably, plaintiff failed to attach these documents to his letter but instead is asking the court's permission to send them now.

Although I question the relevance of these documents, I will give plaintiff an opportunity to submit authenticated copies of the documents because the calendar permits it. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff may have until April 18, 2008, in which to submit to the court and counsel for defendants authenticated copies of any additional documents plaintiff believes will prove that he has exhausted his administrative remedies. Defendants may have until April 25, 2008, to file any objections to the admissibility of these documents. No extensions will be granted.
