Paul Wojcicki has filed a motion for leave to withdraw as counsel for defendant Alfa Leisure, Inc. in this matter. If defendant does not respond to this opportunity to be heard by May 17, 2008, I will assume it has decided to allow judgment to be entered against it on plaintiff's claims and to dismiss its third-party claims against third-party defendant Craft's Trading Center, Inc., with prejudice. In that event, I will direct the clerk of court to enter judgment in favor of plaintiff.
