During the telephonic status conference held March 11, 2009, defendant Kathleen F. Kelly pled guilty to the petty offense of trespass charged against her in the December 23, 2008 information pursuant to Monroe County Ordinance 20-10, assimilated by 18 U.S.C. § 13(a). I accepted Ms. Kelly's guilty plea and imposed a fine of \$75 and earmarked the fine to the Crime Victims Fund, *see* [www.ojp.usdoj.gov/ovc](http://www.ojp.usdoj.gov/ovc). Ms. Kelly advised that she does not intend to pay the fine; not doubting her resolve, I nonetheless gave her a month to pay. We will address any nonpayment in conjunction with other defendants in the 1008 case who make the same decision.

It is ORDERED that not later than April 15, 2009, defendant Kathleen F. Kelly shall pay a fine of \$75 and a special assessment of \$10 to the Clerk of Court for the Western District of Wisconsin.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall earmark this fine for the Crime Victims Fund.
