On July 24, 2008 this court granted defendant Prentice Kilgore's motion to reschedule his trial date to allow sufficient time to prepare for trial. The remaining dates on the schedule are stricken in favor of these new dates:

Submissions for the final pretrial conference: November 4, 2008.

Final pretrial conference: November 6, 1008, at 10:45 a.m.

Final hearing: November 14, 2008 at 3:00 p.m.

Jury selection and trial: November 17, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. Trial will last one day.

Time from July 17, 2008 through November 17, 2008 is excluded from computation under the speedy trial clock pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(8)(A). Kilgore's attorney needs this time to investigate this case and to prepare for trial. Failure to provide this time would unreasonably deny Kilgore and his attorney reasonable time necessary for effective preparation, taking into account the exercise of due diligence. The ends of justice served by proceeding in this fashion outweigh the best interests of the public and the defendant in a speedier trial.
