In an April 1, 2011 order, the Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit reversed the judgment entered in this court and remanded the case with instructions to grant petitioner Gordon Sussman's petition for a writ of habeas corpus "unless the State elects to retry Mr. Sussman." Respondent has filed a motion to stay issuance of the writ pending United States Supreme Court certiorari review. The initial briefing schedule on this motion gave petitioner until May 24, 2011 to respond and respondent until June 3, 2011 to reply. Petitioner filed his brief in response on May 12, along with a motion to amend the briefing schedule to move up respondents time to reply seeing as the response was filed so quickly. I conclude that it is appropriate to do so. Accordingly, petitioner's motion to amend the briefing schedule is GRANTED; respondent will have until May 27, 2011 to file its reply.
