ORDER

This case involves a petition for a writ of habeas corpus brought pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On August 23, 2010, the court granted s petitioner's motion for an extension of time until September 16, 2010 to file his brief in reply to respondent's response. Now he asks for additional time to file his reply brief.

In his motion, he moves reconsideration of the court's April 28, 2010 order denying his motion for a certified copy of the record. As the court previously stated, petitioner is not entitled to a copy of the record under 28 U.S.C. § 2250 because he paid the filing fee in this case. Further, petitioner should have copies of both the documents he filed, the documents served on him by the respondent and the orders entered by the court. Those documents make up the court record in this case. For petitioner's convenience, the court is enclosing a copy of the docket in this case.

Turning to petitioner's request for more time to file his reply brief, petitioner has been given two extensions of time to file his reply brief. Although the court is not convinced that any further extensions are necessary, it will grant petitioner one final extension until October 8, 2010 to file his reply.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that

1. Petitioner Robert Alexander's request for an extension, dkt. # 54, is GRANTED until October 8, 2010.

2. Petitioner's motion for reconsideration of his request for a certified copy of the court record is DENIED.
