Defendant Joel Quinones-Meza has moved under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) for a reduction of his sentence to reflect the latest amendments to the sentencing guidelines. Unfortunately for defendant, the new amendments do not affect his guidelines, because he was sentenced as a career offender and the new amendments leave the career offender guidelines unchanged. <u>United States v. Griffin</u>, 652 F.3d 793, 803 (7th Cir. 2011). This means that his sentence was not based upon a sentencing range that has subsequently been lowered by the Sentencing Commission, 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2). Id.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Joel Quinones-Meza's motion for a sentence

reduction under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) is DENIED.
