Defendant Anselmo Herrera has filed a motion for adjustment of sentence in which he asserts that the Bureau of Prisons has not properly credited him for the time he served in a related state case. Dkt. #278. The government has advised the court that it agrees with defendant's assertion.

After the U.S. Probation Office contacted the Bureau of Prisons to verify defendant's sentence computation, the Bureau confirmed that an error had been made in the computation of defendant's sentence. It has adjusted defendant's sentence from 72 months to 4 years, 8 months and 24 days to credit defendant for the time he served between January 14, 2009 and April 21, 2010. His projected release date is now June 5, 2014.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Anselmo Herrera's motion for adjustment of sentence is DENIED as moot.
