This is a prisoner civil rights case brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 in which plaintiff Bradley Allen Jones contends that defendant Darrel Kuhl failed to protect him from another prisoner when he was at the Columbia County Jail. Now before the court is plaintiff's request for a 45 day extension of time to obtain documents supporting his claim, dkt. 45. There are no deadlines in this case until the date for filing dispositive motions on November 1, 2010. Therefore, plaintiff's motion for an extension of time will be denied as unnecessary. He can renew his motion if, despite trying hard, he is actually unable to obtain the documents in time to file or respond to a dispositive motion.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Bradley Jones's motion for an extension of time, dkt. 45, is DENIED as unnecessary.
