Plaintiff Larry Bracey has filed a motion for a writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum for the appearance of proposed prisoner witness Deshaun Murphy at the November 16, 2011 trial. Dkt. #102. Plaintiff has filed an affidavit stating that Murphy has personal knowledge of defendants' alleged excessive force toward plaintiff and that Murphy is willing to testify voluntarily at trial. Therefore, I will grant plaintiff's motion.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Larry Bracey's motion for a writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum for inmate Deshaun Murphy, dkt. #102, at the Waupun Correctional

Institution in Waupun, Wisconsin, is GRANTED. The Clerk of Court is directed to issue a writ of habeas corpus ad testificandum for the attendance of Murphy at trial beginning on November 16, 2011. The witnesses should arrive at the courthouse no later than 8:00 a.m.
