In an order entered June 14, 2010, I granted plaintiff's request for pauper status on the condition that he prepay \$24.61 of the \$350 filing fee no later than July 7, 2010. Now plaintiff has filed a motion asking the court to extend the payment deadline because he does not believe he will have the necessary funds in his resident account until July 19. He asks for an extension until July 23 in order to allow institution officials time to process his request. Plaintiff's request is reasonable. Therefore, his motion will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for an extension of time, dkt. #5, is GRANTED. Plaintiff is to submit a check or money order made payable to the clerk of court in the amount of \$24.61 on or before July 23, 2010. If, by July 23, 2010, plaintiff fails to prepay the amount he has been ordered to pay, I will dismiss his case for failure to prosecute.
