ORDER

Plaintiff Christopher Rankin has moved for an extension of time in which to oppose defendant's motion to dismiss for lack of jurisdiction. I am canceling the preliminary pretrial conference scheduled for November 4, 2010. ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for an extension of time to file his brief in opposition to defendant's motion to dismiss, dkt. 10, is GRANTED. Plaintiff shall file his opposition brief by November 1, 2010. Defendant will have until November 12, 2010 to serve and file its reply.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the preliminary pretrial conference scheduled to be held on November 4, 2010 is CANCELED.
