ORDER

Defendant Odell Dobbs has filed a document entitled “Notice of a Motion for the Forwarding of the Records” in which he asks that the court order the clerk of court to forward all transcripts from his criminal case no. 08-cr-102-bbc to the court of appeals to be included as part of the record on his appeal in 10-cv-584-bbc.

The clerk of court certified and transmitted the record on appeal to the court of appeals on February 17, 2011 in case no. 10-cv-584-bbc. Because defendant’s appeal is from the denial of his motion under 28 U.S.C. § 2255 (case no. 10-cv-584), the sentencing transcripts from his criminal case (08-cr-102-bbc) are not included in the record. In the event the court of appeals determines that it requires the transcripts, it will make that

request to the clerk of courts and the transcripts will be certified and transmitted to the court of appeals. Therefore, defendant's motion will be denied as unnecessary.

ORDER

Defendant Odell Dobbs's motion for the forwarding of the records is DENIED as unnecessary.
