On October 15, 2010, defendant Michael D. Ball filed a motion for post conviction relief under 28 U.S.C. § 2255. On November 24, 2010, I denied some of the allegations in defendant's motion and stayed a ruling on the remaining allegations. I gave defendant until December 8, 2010 to file an addendum which supports those allegations.

Defendant has now filed a motion for an extension of time to file his supplemental information. He states that he needs more time because he is currently involved in a program at the institution which restricts his access to the law library.
