Defendant Jarrett has written to the court requesting additional time in which to submit an affidavit in support of his motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255. On December 1, 2010, the government requested an extension of time to file their brief in opposition. That request was granted and the court set a modified briefing schedule. Under the new schedule, the government has until December 16, 2010 to file its brief in opposition and defendant has until December 28, 2010 to file his reply. This new deadline should give defendant sufficient time to file the affidavit or any other supporting materials. If not, the defendant can renew his request for an extension at that time.

ORDER

Defendant's request for an extension of time to file an affidavit in support of his § 2255 motion is DENIED as premature.
