ORDER

In an order dated November 8, 2010, I assessed plaintiff an initial partial payment of the filing fee in the amount of \$3.28 and gave him until November 22, 2010 in which to submit the payment. Now plaintiff has filed a motion asking the court to extend his deadline because he doesn't have enough money in his account. Plaintiff's motion for extension of time to pay his initial partial filing fee will be granted. Plaintiff is reminded that if he does not have the money to make the initial partial payment in his regular account, he must arrange with prison authorities to pay some or all of the assessment from his release account. Before prison officials take any portion of that amount from plaintiff's release account, they may first take from plaintiff's regular account whatever amount up to the \$3.28. Plaintiff should show a copy of this order to prison officials to insure that they are aware they should send plaintiff's initial partial payment to this court.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Dawon Jones' motion for extension of time is GRANTED. The deadline within which Jones is to pay the \$3.28 initial partial payment of the \$350 filing is extended to December 20, 2010. If, by December 20, 2010, plaintiff fails to pay the initial partial payment, then he will be held to have withdrawn this action voluntarily. In that event, the clerk of court is directed to close the file without prejudice to plaintiff refiling his case later.
