On November 8, 2010, the court held its final pretrial conference. Defendant Jon Lee was present with his attorney Peter Bartelt. The government was represented by Assistant U.S. Attorney Laura Przybylinski-Finn.

Prior to the hearing the court circulated draft voir dire questions, jury instructions and a special verdict form. The parties suggested minor changes to the voir dire, which the court adopted, confirmed that Lee's requested jury instructions were in the packet, and corrected a typographical error. Because these changes were small and immaterial, I am not attaching the updated documents to this order.

Lee confirmed that he had no in limine issues for the court and confirmed that he did not object to the government's request to provide a *Santiago* proffer at the final hearing.

The parties predict a two-day trial that might spill into Wednesday for deliberations. One alternate juror will suffice. Lee is released on conditions and has access to street clothes. The parties are aware they must use the court's ELMO to present evidence. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
