SCHEDULING ORDER

At an April 11, 2011 unrecorded telephonic status conference with the government and with defendant Jacob Stadfeld's new attorney, defense counsel reported that the defense team needs at least several months adequately to prepare for trial. In consultation with both sides, the court set the following schedule:

May 9, 2011 is defendant's deadline to seek leave to file any additional pretrial motions, with any proposed motions and supporting briefs filed simultaneously. The government's response is due May 20, 2011, with any reply due May 27, 2011. The court does not intend to hold a motion hearing.

Deadlines to disclose expert witnesses: Government: July 1, 2011

Defendant: July 22, 2011

Submissions for the final pretrial conference: July 27, 2011.

Final pretrial conference: July 29, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

Final hearing before the trial judge: August 11, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.

Jury selection and trial: August 15, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. The predicted trial length now is four or five days. Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3161(h)(7), time shall continue to be excluded from the speedy trial until the trial date so that defense counsel may prepare adequately for trial.
