At the August 25, 2011 pretrial motion hearing, defendant Gale Rachuy's replacement attorney, Joseph Sommers, explained why he needed two more months adequately to prepare for trial. The court expressed skepticism that any further delay actually would produce any useful results for the defense, viewing this as Rachuy simply pitching his discredited theories to a new audience. The government, however, did not oppose the extension, so the court acceded to the request, excluding all time from computation under the speedy trial clock. The current schedule is stricken in favor of this new, final schedule:

Rachuy may file pretrial motion motions only with leave of court.

The government must complete disclosure of experts not later than October 17, 2011.

The defense must disclose experts not later than October 31, 2011.

Submissions for the final pretrial conference are due November 1, 2011.

The final pretrial conference shall be November 3, 2011 at 9:00 a.m.

The final hearing before Judge Conley shall be November 8, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.

Jury selection and trial shall begin November 14, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. The parties are predicting anywhere from a three to five-day trial.
