ORDER

At a March 6, 2012 telephonic status conference, the parties agreed that defendant Shaon Arch appeared to be competent enough to be returned to this district from FMC-Springfield. *See* dkt. 53. Arch now has returned and has spoken (telephonically) with his attorney. At the April 17, 2012 telephonic scheduling conference, Arch's attorney advised the court that he is not contesting competency at this time and that therefore, the court may find Arch competent without holding a hearing. The government concurred with this result.

Therefore, pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 4241, the court finds that defendant Shaon Arch is legally competent in that he is able to understand the nature and consequences of the proceedings against him and is able to assist properly in his defense.
