PRETRIAL MOTION  
HEARING ORDER

On August 6, 2010, this court held the pretrial motion hearing and an evidentiary hearing. Defendant Merari Garcia-Arcos was present with his attorney, Victor Arellano. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Grant Johnson.

Prior to the hearing, Garcia-Arcos filed a series of discovery motions and a motion to suppress evidence. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the motions with both sides, I denied as unnecessary all of the discovery motions. We took evidence on the motion to suppress (dkt. 21) and set briefing: defendant's first brief must be filed and served not later than August 13, 2010, with the government response due August 20, 2010 and any reply due August 25, 2010. The parties had no other substantive matters to bring to the court's attention.
