ORDER

Plaintiff David W. Watts filed a civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 and received leave to proceed with claims against two state prison officials, defendants Dan Westfield and Rick Raemisch. Dispositive motions are due no later than February 28, 2014. Plaintiff has now filed a motion to extend this deadline and others because he has been transferred out of state on an unrelated matter. Plaintiff speculates that this out-of-state transfer will impede his ability to respond in the event that defendants file a dispositive motion.

This case has been pending for nearly four years. No further delays or extensions will be granted without a showing of good cause. Plaintiff's motion, which seeks an extension for hypothetical reasons, does not meet this showing. Therefore, plaintiff's request for an extension of time will be denied.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that

1. Plaintiff David Watts' motion for an extension of time, dkt. # 91, is DENIED.

2. Both parties are advised that no further delays or extensions of time will be considered without a showing of good cause.
