Counsel in this case have advised the court that the remaining defendants in this case, Charles Duffley and Benjamin Morris have filed for bankruptcy. (On July 5, 2011 the case was stayed as to defendant Dalphis, LLC, and on February 7, 2012 as to defendant D&S, Inc. after those defendants filed for bankruptcy.)

Because the proceedings in bankruptcy may dispose of this entire case, IT IS ORDERED that the case is DISMISSED without prejudice, subject to the condition that this order of dismissal shall be vacated in the event that any of the bankruptcy proceedings are terminated without disposing of the rights of the parties in this case or a timely request is made by any party to vacate this order to dismiss without prejudice, or for any other reason necessary to prevent manifest injustice. In the event that this order of dismissal is

vacated, the parties shall have all such rights as if this case had not been dismissed.
