A telephone status conference was held in this case on April 30, 2014, before United States District Judge Barbara B. Crabb. Gregory Everts participated on behalf of plaintiff Doli Pulungan; Assistant United States Attorney Meredith Duchemin and Leslie Herje participated on behalf of the United States.

Mr. Everts informed the court that plaintiff's visa was rescinded because no hearing date was pending. Once a new date is set, plaintiff can reapply for a visa. Therefore, the parties agreed on July 24, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. for the evidentiary hearing. The parties anticipate the hearing will last no more than 2 days.

The parties also discussed the use of an interpreter at the hearing. Plaintiff is responsible for finding and paying an interpreter. Because Mr. Everts is recruited counsel through the State Bar, he may seek reimbursement for the cost of an interpreter through the Western District Bar Association Pro Bono Fund, Inc.

Because of the new hearing date, the parties asked the court to extend the discovery deadline. That request is granted. The discovery deadline is extended to July 14, 2014, except for the deposition of plaintiff which may take place anytime upon his return to the

United States and prior to the July 24, 2014 hearing.
