ORDER

A telephone status conference was held in this case on November 14, 2013 before United States District Judge Barbara B. Crabb. Gregory Everts participated on behalf of plaintiff Doli Pulungan; Assistant United States Attorney Meredith Duchemin participated on behalf of the United States.

The purpose of the hearing was to discuss the logistics of setting a hearing at which plaintiff will have an opportunity to prove that he is actually innocent of the charges brought against him by the United States. Mr. Everts discussed the difficulties inherent in bringing plaintiff from Jakarta, Indonesia, to the United States for a hearing. He advised the court that plaintiff will need a court order to attach to his visa application if he is going to have a chance to gain permission to come to the United States. Counsel are to file a proposed order.

In coordination with counsel, the court set the following deadlines:

Discovery deadline: March 3, 2014.

Final pretrial Submissions: March 24, 2014.

Court Trial: March 31, 2014. The parties predict the hearing will take no more than 2 days.
