FURTHER, IT IS ORDERED that the remaining parties are enjoined permanently from making any further actual or implied claims, demands and causes of action, asserted or unasserted, liquidated or unliquidated, or bringing any action or proceeding in any forum, arising out of or in connection with Prudential relating to Group Life Insurance policy number G-32000 issued by Prudential, through the Office of Servicemembers's Group Life Insurance, which provided Group Life insurance benefits pursuant to the SGLI statute, 38 U.S.C. 1865 *et seq.* to the United States Department to Veterans Affairs and providing coverage on the life of Michael De Jesus, Sr., and payment of death benefits in the amount of \$100,000, plus claim interest in the amount of \$165.36 and premium refund of \$26.00 due thereunder.
