ORDER ON MOTION
AND
AMENDING THE SCHEDULE

At an April 11, 2012 telephonic motion hearing, it became clear through discussion with counsel that a lot of hurdles for both sides could be cleared if we extended the schedule. Both sides were amenable to bumping all current dates about three months. This ameliorated the concerns that had led to defendant's motion for sanctions (dkt. 10).

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that defendant's motion for sanctions is DENIED as unnecessary, and that the current schedule is stricken and replaced by the dates that follow. In all other respects, the preliminary pretrial conference order and all attachments to it remain in effect.

Responses: February 1, 2013

Telephonic Final Pretrial Conference: February 13, 2013 at 3:00 p.m.

Jury Selection and Trial: Tuesday, February 19, 2013 at 9:00 a.m.

The estimated length of trial remains four days.
