MEMORANDUM

Plaintiff Sylvester Jackson is proceeding on claims that various prison officials violated his Eighth Amendment right to adequate medical care by failing to treat his toes after surgery and failing to treat his back pain. In an order dated June 11, 2014, I appointed Tim Edwards to represent plaintiff. Dkt. #126. Trial is scheduled for August 13, 2015. Dkt. #128.

In a letter to the court dated February 1, 2015, plaintiff complained that he had sent four letters to Edwards over the last three months and had not received a response. Plaintiff asked the court to “contact the appointed attorney and find out what’s the problem.” Dkt. #129. In response, Lester Pines, a colleague of Edwards at the same law firm, filed a notice of appearance and a letter in which he explains that he is taking over the representation of

plaintiff because Edwards has been out of the office for medical reasons. Dkt. #132.

In light of those circumstances, the delay in responding to plaintiff's letters is understandable. Accordingly, I see no reason for court action at this time.
