Astrue has moved to remand this case under sentence six of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) because the claim file containing the administrative law judge's May 2009 decision cannot be located. The Commissioner has advised the court that upon remand, an administrative law judge will hold a new hearing and prepare a new decision.

Plaintiff Eleanor Catherine Clifford has advised the court that she does not object to the sentence six remand.
