SECOND AMENDED
SCHEDULING ORDER

11-cr-7-wmc

At the June 15, 2011 telephonic conference, the court reset schedule as follows:

- 1) Deadline to disclose expert witnesses: Defendant: July 18, 2011
- 2) Submissions for the final pretrial conference, namely proposed voir dire questions, jury instructions and motions in limine must be filed and served not later than July 19, 2011.
- 3) The final pretrial conference shall be July 21, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.
- 4) The final hearing before the trial judge shall be July 26, 2011 at 3:00 p.m.
- 5) Jury selection and trial shall begin August 1, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. The predicted trial length is one to two days. The parties are jointly responsible for alerting the clerk of court forthwith if a jury need not be called.

All time from June 7, 2011 through August 1, 2011 is excluded from computation on the speedy trial clock in order to allow defendant's new attorney properly to prepare for trial.
