Other than one correction to the voir dire, the parties had no proposed changes to the court's draft voir dire question or jury instructions, so I have not attached copies to this order.

The government has provided notice of intent to offer specified other acts evidence pursuant to F.R. Ev. 404(b), *see* dkt. 32. Juarez objects to introduction of these other alleged cocaine sales at trial. The issue is framed for resolution at the final hearing. The parties had no other substantive matters to bring to the court's attention.

As for housekeeping, the parties predict a two-day trial, for which one alternate juror will suffice. Juarez has access to street clothes for trial. The parties are aware they must use the court's ELMO to present evidence.
