On April 24, 2012 the court held telephonic hearing on defendant Steve Schmidt's second motion to amend the schedule (dkt. 34), filed on March 26, 2012. Schmidt's attorneys report that they still need more prep time even though the trial date in *United States v. Atherton* was pushed back at counsel's request. New counsel for codefendant Darren Ulatowski did not oppose the motion, noting that he would benefit from extra preparation time due to his recent entry into this case and a busy state court trial calendar. The fact that both defendants now are detained has not dissuaded them from seeking more time for trial preparation. After discussing the request with all parties, I reluctantly granted the motion, struck the remainder of the existing schedule and replaced it with these dates:

Expert witness disclosures: Government: July 30, 2012

Defendants: August 27, 2012

Submissions for final pretrial conference: September 10, 2012.

Final pretrial conference: September 13, 2012 at 1:30 p.m.

Final hearing: September 18, 2012 at 3:00 p.m.

Jury selection and trial: September 24, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.

Time is excluded from computation on the speedy trial clock from March 26, 2012 until September 24, 2012 to allow time necessary for both defendants properly to prepare for trial, taking into account due diligence, with supporting facts set forth in Schmidt's motion and during the telephonic hearing by counsel for both defendants.
