ORDER

The court is again confronted by a motion to withdraw as plaintiff's counsel by David Anstaett, Autumn Nero and Jesse Bair from the law firm of Perkins Coie LLP, who were recruited by the court to assist Mr. Schlemm. (Dkt. #129.) At his request, the motion indicates "Mr. Schlemm believes that counsel have committed legal malpractice and that he wishes the Court to appoint new counsel." Given the quality of the work of plaintiff's counsel in this matter, as well as their past work in both highly compensated and *pro bono* representations before this court, Schlemm's belief is extremely hard to credit. More importantly for the purposes of the pending motion, as he has been repeatedly advised in the past, plaintiff has no legal right to appointed counsel in this case, nor will the court recruit new counsel in light of Schlemm's apparent inability to work with his current counsel. (Dkts. ##100, 106.)

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the motion of plaintiff's counsel is GRANTED and they are relieved of further responsibility in this case as set forth in Wis. SCR 20:1.16(d). Plaintiff is once again left to represent himself in this matter.
