ORDER

On March 21, 2012, I directed plaintiff William Reese to submit a supplement to his trust fund account statement by April 12, 2012 so that I could assess an initial partial payment of the \$350 fee for filing this case. When plaintiff submitted his complaint, the trust fund account statement that he provided was not from the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of this lawsuit. It did, however, include two months of the appropriate period, from September 16, 2011 to November 11, 2011, so I directed him to submit a supplement for the rest of the six-month period. In response to the March 21 order, plaintiff has not submitted the required supplemental trust fund account statement, but instead has submitted a motion for extension of time.

In his motion, plaintiff requests an additional 45 to 60 days to submit his trust fund account statement. He explains that he was transferred to another facility and did not receive the March 21 order until April 4, 2012. He further says that he is awaiting a copy request so that he can order the trust fund account statement from the Dodge County Detention Facility in Juneau, Wisconsin. I will not give plaintiff 60 days, or even 45 days, but I will allow him an additional 30 days to submit his supplemental trust fund account statement.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff William Reese's motion for extension of time to submit his supplemental trust fund account statement, dkt. 7, is GRANTED in part. Plaintiff may have until May 16, 2012, in which to submit a trust fund account statement covering the period beginning approximately November 15, 2011 and ending March 16, 2012. If, by May 16, 2012, plaintiff fails to respond to this order, then the clerk of court is directed to close this file without prejudice to plaintiff's filing his case at a later date.
