The above-captioned civil cases are before the court for a determination of attorney fees and costs. Defendants Helga and Christopher Swatzak filed notices of removal in each of these state court foreclosure cases. In an October 30, 2012 order, I remanded the cases, concluded that defendants had no objectively reasonable ground for removing the cases, granted plaintiff Associated Bank's request for reimbursement of costs and attorney fees under 28 U.S.C. § 1447(c) and ordered plaintiff to file an itemization of the fees incurred

in moving for remand. Plaintiff has now filed such an itemization, seeking reimbursement in the amount of \$1,104.60 (\$1,092.00 in attorney fees and \$12.60 in costs). Although defendants were invited to object to the amount claimed by plaintiff, they have not done so. I conclude that plaintiff's modest request is reasonable.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Associated Bank is awarded costs and fees in the amount of \$1,104.60 against defendants Helga and Christopher Swatzak.
