ORDER

Judgment was entered dismissing this case on November 16, 2012. In an order entered on March 7, 2012, the court denied plaintiff Alan David McCormack's motion for an extension of the time to file a motion to amend the judgment and his motion to alter or amend the judgment. Dkt. #36. Plaintiff has now filed a motion for reconsideration, dkt. #37, asserting that defendants prevented him from meeting the deadline for mailing the motion he was bringing under Fed. R. Civ. P. 59(e). However, the only detail that plaintiff provides in support of his motion is that he had a dispute with the mailroom in February 2013. Even if this dispute kept him from mailing his motion, it would not change the fact that it occurred well past his Rule 59(e) deadline. Moreover, in the March 7 order I

concluded that plaintiff's arguments for amending the judgment lacked merit and he has not challenged this conclusion. Accordingly, plaintiff's motion for reconsideration will be denied.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Alan David McCormack's motion for reconsideration, dkt. #37, is DENIED.
