The parties have filed a stipulation for attorney fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. 2412, in the amount of \$13,895.00, and costs in the amount of \$805.00 in full satisfaction of any claims for fees for costs in this case.

Further, the parties agree that the award may be paid to plaintiff's counsel but may be offset to satisfy any pre-existing debt owed by plaintiff Mutter to the United States pursuant to Astrue v. Ratliff, 130 S.Ct. 2521 (2010).

After entry of this order, if counsel for the parties can verify that plaintiff owes no pre-existing debt subject to offset, defendant will direct that the award be made payable to plaintiff's counsel under the EAJA assignment signed by plaintiff and his counsel.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Shahab Jalali is awarded attorney fees in the amount of \$13,895.00 and costs in the amount of \$805.00. These amounts are to be made payable to plaintiff's attorney, Charles Binder, contingent upon payment of money owed to the United States.
