Plaintiff Eric Hall is proceeding in this case on his claims that defendants violated plaintiff's constitutional rights by conspiring against him to frame plaintiff for the theft of two trucks, resulting in revocation of plaintiff's probation and subsequent incarceration. On March 11, 2013, defendants Felton, Gruebele, Jones, Naugle and Varriale filed a motion for summary judgment for plaintiff's failure to comply with the State's Notice of Claim Statute, Wis Stats. §893.82. *See* dkt. 16. The clerk set briefing on the motion and plaintiff was given until April 11, 2013 in which to file his opposition. Plaintiff has filed a letter requesting an extension of time to respond to this motion because he is "unfamiliar with how things need to be done. . ."

Because the court has not yet held a preliminary pretrial conference, plaintiff has not received a copy of this court's procedures for filing or opposing motions like these. For this

reason, I will delay the briefing of defendants' motion until after I have held a pretrial conference in this case, which will be scheduled as soon as defendant Ott has filed an answer to the complaint.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that defendants Felton, Gruebele, Jones, Naugle and Varriale s' motion for summary judgment, dkt. 16, is STAYED pending a telephonic pretrial conference.
