ORDER

Pro se prisoner Donna Konitzer aka S.A. Konitzer is proceeding on several claims that prison officials violated her rights under the Eighth Amendment and state law by failing to provide appropriate treatment for her gender identity disorder. In a one-page motion, plaintiff is requesting to amend the scheduling order to give her more time to find counsel and an expert. Dkt. #51. However, plaintiff filed this case in 2012. If she has not been able to find a lawyer or an expert in almost two years, I see little reason to believe that an additional three months will make a difference. Plaintiff does not suggest that any lawyers or experts are currently considering her case.

Although I am denying plaintiff's motion, this does not leave her without redress. In an order dated December 23, 2013, dkt. #36, I denied plaintiff's motion for assistance in recruiting counsel because she had not provided letters from at least three lawyers who had

declined to take her case. Once plaintiff fulfills that requirement, she is free to renew her motion for assistance in recruiting counsel.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Donna Dawn Konitzer's motion to amend the scheduling order, dkt. #51, is DENIED.
