Defendant Jaime Santoyo-Lagunas has filed a motion in which he asks that he be credited with the 132 days he served in jail prior to the sentencing in this case. The motion will be denied as premature. When defendant was sentenced in this case, his sentence was ordered to run consecutively to the three-year sentence imposed upon him in the Circuit Court for Juneau County, Case No. 10CF153. Defendant will complete the service of his state sentence on June 13, 2013, and will be taken into federal custody to begin service of the four-month sentence imposed upon him in this case. At that time, the Bureau of Prisons will calculate defendant's federal sentence, including any credit to which he is entitled. If defendant disagrees with the calculation, he may renew his motion at that time.

ORDER

Defendant's motion to correct sentence is DENIED as premature.
