Defendant Jarrell Knight has filed a motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) and Amendment 782, seeking a modification of his sentence imposed by this court on February 8, 2013. Knight pleaded guilty to distribution of heroin in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1) and 851. At sentencing, he was also determined to be a career offender as defined in U.S.S.G. § 4B1.1.

The court takes note of the progress Mr. Knight appears to have made while incarcerated, particularly the insights he eloquently describes in his letters to this court. Hopefully, Knight will be able to continue on a path of self-reflection, change his world view and prepare for a successful release to a crime-free life style.

Unfortunately, the amendment to the guidelines does not apply to him because his sentence was determined by his status as a career offender, *not* by drug quantity. Therefore, his request for a sentence reduction must be denied.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Jarrell Knight's motion for a sentence reduction under 18 U.S.C. § 3582 and Amendment 782 is DENIED.
