Plaintiff Kenny Williams has filed a civil suit pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) for review of a final decision of the Commissioner of Social Security denying plaintiff's application for social security benefits. Plaintiff seeks to commence this lawsuit without prepayment of the filing fees and costs or providing security therefor, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915.

From the affidavit of indigency plaintiff has submitted, I find that he is unable to prepay the fees and costs of commencing this action or to give security therefor.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that Kenny William's petition for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* is GRANTED. The United States Marshal shall serve the summons and complaint on defendant Michael Astrue. The clerk of court is directed to forward the complaint, summons and marshal service forms to the United States Marshal.
