After plaintiff Michael Kingsley's counsel withdrew from his representation, I rescheduled the trial in this case for December 8, 2014. Because of a scheduling conflict, the trial date must be moved again. The scheduling order is AMENDED to reflect that jury selection remains slotted for December 8, 2014, but trial will begin on December 11, 2014.

Since his release from prison, plaintiff has not updated his address. His Department of Corrections file provides an address that appears to be the address of his supervised release agent. This order will be sent to that address. If plaintiff receives this order, he should inform the court immediately of his updated address. If plaintiff does not receive this order, he will be notified of its contents upon his required communication with the court. Plaintiff is reminded that pursuant to the September 22, 2014 order, dkt. #62, he is

required to report to the court his intention to go to trial no later than December 1, 2014.

If plaintiff does not report to the court as ordered, his case will be dismissed for failure to prosecute on December 2, 2014.
